To whom it may concern,

I have been in correspondence with Mr. George Hobbs over the past few weeks regarding breaches to the Marine Conservation Regulations, namely the lifting of marine life from the water in a Wildlife Interaction Zone (WIZ), by persons employed as boat captains and or mates by the same company that Mr. Hobbs is employed by. Mr. Hobbs has both sent in photographs showing breaches of the law as well as requested clarification on certain points of the law with the stated intention of educating the crews of the vessels he works on.

Recently Mr. Hobbs copied me on a few e-mails that he had sent to his employers regarding the lifting of marine life from the water by the boat crews he works with. It appears to me that the incidents and actions he describes in the e-mails are true as they have been backed up by photos, sent to myself, which clearly show the breaches of the WIZ regulations mentioned.
